Congress:

Don't Harm Quality Nursing Home Care

America's nursing homes have achieved outstanding quality improvements in recent years, thanks in large part to stable Medicare funding. But while nursing homes get only 4.8% of Medicare dollars, the Administration's proposed budget hits nursing homes with 26% of Medicare cuts in the first year alone. Total cuts would amount to \$11 billion over five years.



Now quality nursing home care is threatened.

These cuts will reverse quality improvements at a time when seniors increasingly need the care of skilled nursing facilities. The Administration's budget also calls for continued cuts to Medicaid—a program that already underfunds our nation's nursing homes by nearly \$4.5 billion per year. Budget cuts will harm millions of caring nursing home employees and the 1.7 million vulnerable elderly Medicare beneficiaries who require quality nursing home care.
